ARTWORK FORMAT

Artwork must be the student's original work! No adult help allowed nor the use of artificial intelligence.

ALL artwork should be 8 inches by 8 inches square. Artwork must be submitted on smooth paper (no textured paper as it is difficult to scan). ONLY USE COLORED PENCILS. All artwork must also have the student's name, grade, teacher's name, and school to be accepted.

- 4. Independence Day Celebration July
 - a. Must include an American flag and fireworks
- 5. Stars, Stripes, and Harvest Night October
